It's hard to believe nineteen years have passed since I first ran for the New Mexico State Legislature -- four years in the state House of Representatives and fifteen years in the state Senate where I have been the Majority Leader since 2016. The past sixty-day legislative session was extremely productive. Bills I sponsored which are now law include:

- The Regional Water System Resiliency Act which allows water systems to regionalize and take advantage of economies of scale (SB 1); and
- The Land of Enchantment Legacy fund to provide recurring dollars for conservation programs (SB 9).

Other highlights were:

- Negotiating a bipartisan medical malpractice compromise (SB 523);
- Reforming the board of the Interstate Stream Commission (SB 58); and,
- Eliminating most driver's license suspensions for failure to pay fines (SB 47).

Yet, there is much more work to be done. This is why **I am running for re-election to the New Mexico Senate.**

To make this happen, I'm asking for your help.

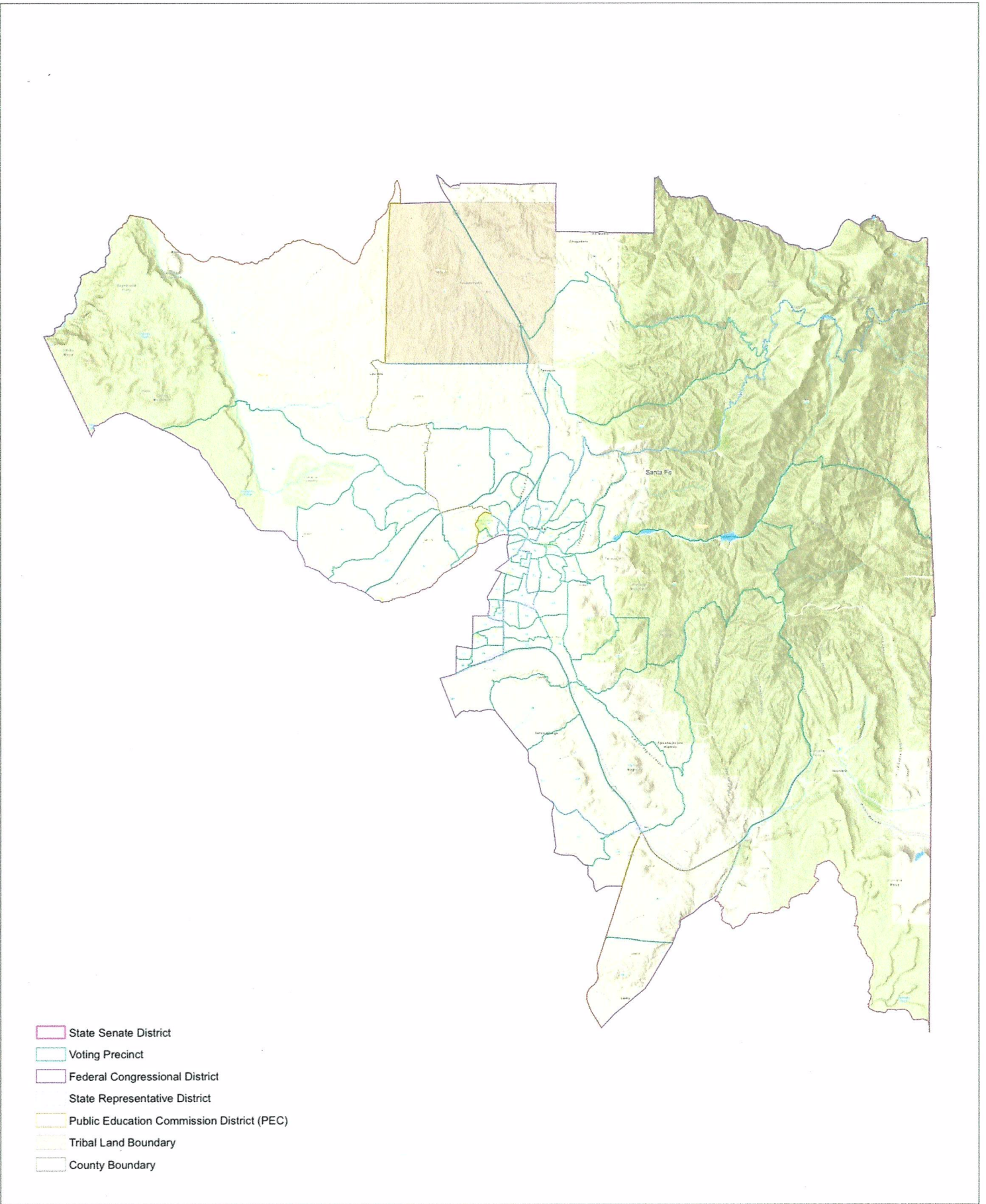
